Law & Technology Award Regulation

Abreu Advogados is a leading law firm in Portugal, distinguished by its pioneering spirit and the innovation it brings to all its activities.

In the context of the ongoing technological revolution, which has numerous effects for the legal field, Abreu Advogados decided to establish the Law and Technology Award. The aim of this award is to foster interest in the relationship between Law and Technology and to facilitate the integration into Abreu Advogados of trainee lawyers prepared to practice in the new technological paradigm.

Article 1

The Law and Technology Award rewards law students with an interest in technological areas and a desire to cross the themes of law and technology.

Article 2

1. The competition offers the winner of the award, who passes the interview, an invitation to join Abreu Advogados as a trainee lawyer.
2. The winner will also receive a cash prize.
3. The jury may award the prize ex aequo to two or more contestants, with the prize money being divided between them.
4. The jury may award honorable mentions, and Abreu Advogados may offer the contestants who benefit from them advantageous conditions for access to a traineeship.

Article 3

Final year law students and law graduates studying for a master's degree or LL.M. are eligible to apply.

Artigo 4º

1. Candidates can apply by submitting a summary of an answer to a question defined by the Abreu Advogados Knowledge Institute, as well as their CV.
2. The jury will then select the candidates who will be invited to present their answers orally.
3. From among the candidates referred to in number 2, up to three candidates are invited for an interview.
4. Following the interview, the winner is chosen and invited to join the firm as a trainee lawyer in September 2027.

Article 5

The competition notice will indicate:

- a) The question to be addressed;
- b) The deadline and method for submitting the application;
- c) The judging panel;
- d) The value of the prize money.

Article 6

1. When grading candidates, the jury will assess:
 - a) the ability to understand the problems involved;
 - b) the ability to frame and analyze legal issues;
 - c) creativity;
 - d) the ability to solve problems;
 - e) clarity and the ability to argue and communicate.
2. There can be no complaint or appeal against the jury's deliberations.

Article 7

Any doubts or omissions in the interpretation or application of these Regulations will be resolved by the Knowledge Institute's Board of Directors, which may delegate to the competition jury.
